SC, BC, OBC, Minority Cell:

This cell in college plays a crucial role in ensuring inclusivity and equips opportunities for students from marginalized communities. It serves as a dedicated platform to address the concerns and welfare of students belonging to scheduled caste, scheduled Tribes, and other backward classes and minority communities. It facilitates access to scholarship, financial aid, and other support mechanisms to promote educational, advancements and social economic empowerment among these students. It fosters supportive environment that values diversity, and promotes social justice within the college community.

Scholarship for the Students:

Scholarships in the college provides crucial financial support and recognition to deserving students based on academic merit, financial need, or specific criteria such as sports or cultural achievements. These scholarships not only elevate the financial burden of education but also motivates students to excel in their studies and extra-curricular activities. They come in various forms, including government – funded schemes, Institutional grants, and private scholarships, catering to wide range of students, background and aspirations. Scholarship not only encourage academic excellence but also promotes diversity, equity, and inclusivity within the college community by ensuring access to quality education for all deserving students.

There is a provision for scholarship and stipend funded by the state and central government for SC students to reduce the dropout rates of the students. Increased access to education, empowerment, social inclusion and reduction of disparities is therefore taken care of by addressing the financial challenges faced by scheduled castes and other underprivileged groups. Under the consolidated scheme, students are eligible for yearly stipend of ₹12,000 and ₹2000 for Books. During the year 2023-24, total 40 students availed for SC scholarship and 14 students for post-matric scholarship for BC students. These schemes helps and contribute to a more inclusive and supportive educational environment.

Other/Merit scholarship:

In addition to scholarships specifically for students belonging to particular categories, the college also offers some scholarships purely on merit basis

Stipend scheme for grandchildren of freedom fighters (2010–11) pursuing higher education in government/non-government colleges of Haryana

In recognition of the third generation of grandchildren of freedom fighters, the department has suggested that they will be awarded a scholarship equal to that which is acceptable for children from scheduled caste families. The following may be the scholarship rate – ₹2000 as a one-time Book allowance and ₹1000 as a monthly stipend for 12 months, for colleges.

Scheme of government of Haryana for marriage scholarship to undergraduate girls students

This scholarship is awarded to female students enrolled in government colleges who have passed their 10+2 exam with at least 60% marks. This scheme has no income restriction. The scholarship is awarded to 10 female students per college. Each student receives a scholarship worth ₹3000.

Haryana state meritorious incentive scheme for students who attain merit positions in annual university examination:

This scheme is college – specific and three meritorious students in each stream who stood first, second and third in the annual university examination will be given this incentive. The merit list is prepared separately for general category and SC category students. The incentive is awarded separately for each stream, that is arts/commerce. The students who stands first in the merit is given ₹5000, second ₹3000, and the student who stands third in the merit is given ₹2000.

Haryana state meritorious incentive scheme for the students who attain merit position in CBSE annual exam:

Under the scheme, two students (one boy, and one girl) are given an annual incentive based on their top position/preference in annual CBSE 10th and 12th annual exams every year.

In capital letters, scheme of state government, (Haryana education department) merit scholarship in colleges for general university education:

This scholarship is awarded to top rank – holders students in 10+2 exam and enrolled in government colleges. This scheme has no income restriction. Each student receives a scholarship worth ₹3600.

Scheme of post-matric scholarship to lower income group students for student studies in India:

The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to lower income groups to enable them to complete their education. The scholarships for lower income group students are awarded based on the total annual income from all sources of the parents/guardians of the applicant and not based on caste. For this purpose, the applicant are divided into two slabs, one with income up to ₹12,000 per annum and the other with income over ₹12,000, but not exceeding ₹20000 per annum.

Earn While You Learn Scheme:

The "Earn while you Learn" scheme in the college empower students to gain practical work experience while pursuing their studies. This is a government of Haryana run scheme in regular practice in the college intended to benefit genuinely needy and meritorious students by engaging them in different departments/ laboratories. In value of work done, they are paid hundred rupees per hour. This is an initiative to promote dignity of labour and self-reliance in the students. The selection process is completely transparent one, where in student are judged on basis of factors, including economic backgrounds and academic performances by a well constituted committee of senior members. In the year 2023-24, 10 students gained financial help through the scheme. Our college was granted rupees 40,000 to be distributed among students involved. Mrs. Poonam Jakhar, associate professor of geography is the convener of the committee.

Placement/Entrepreneur Cell:

The Placement cell operates with unwavering diligence, fostering a bridge between academia and industry. The meticulous planning and strategic initiatives ensures that our students mark on promising career journeys. The dynamic and resourceful approach of the cell not only secure placements but also empower students with the skills and confidence for professional success, making it an invaluable asset to our college community. Our college received grant for the upliftment of the students from the department. During the session, following programs were organized from this grant:

Passport scheme:

The state government introduced a scheme of making passport for the UG final year students in 2020–21. The decision helps the students in pursuing higher studies, medical facilities, business purposes, etc. The object is to ease the process to obtain a passport and encourage students to pursue higher education. For this purpose a nodal officer was assigned and trained by the passport authorities. In Government College for girls sector 52, Gurugram, we have a committee of 4 members headed by nodal officer Mr. Jitender Yadav.

For applying passport, first of all, we register the students on the online portal, www.passportindia.gov.in, the passport application fee of ₹1500 is paid by the state government and the application is processed. It is followed by the appointment fixing by the students on the

online portal and finally passports are issued to the students by the passport authority after the police verification and document verification. In our college approx. 80 plus passports of the UG final year student were successfully made till date.

NSS:

The national service scheme of the college is a voluntary organization that aims to instill the spirit of social service and community engagement among students. Through various activities, such as blood donation camps, cleanliness drive, literacy programs, and awareness campaign on health, hygiene, and environmental conservation, NSS promotes active citizenship and civic responsibility. जैविक उद्यान -"अपनी माटी"

महाविद्यालय प्रांगण में जुलाई 2022 से जैविक उद्यान के अन्तर्गत महाविद्यालय की छात्राओं द्वारा जैविक खेती की जा रही है। आज के युग में ज्यादा पैदावार एवं मुनाफे की होड़ में खेती में रसायनिक उर्वरकों एवं कीटनाशकों का प्रयोग बढ़ता जा रहा है जिसके परिणामस्वरूप लोगों में अनेक बिमारियां फैलती जा रही हैं, जिसमें सबसे घातक कैंसर दुनिया को निगलते जा रहा है।

रसायन एवं उर्वरकों के दुष्प्रभाव से बचने के लिए इस महाविद्यालय में यह परम्परा प्रारम्भ की गई है। हम इस उद्यान में रसायन एवं उर्वरकों का प्रयोग बिल्कुल नहीं करते, केवल पत्तों, गोबर एवं घास-फूस के खाद का प्रयोग करते हैं। इसमें दो-तीन टीचर इंचार्ज के निर्देशन में छात्राएं सब्जियां, फल आदि उगाती हैं तथा खाद-बीज के बाद जो भी मुनाफा होता है वह छात्राओं का ही होता है।

इससे भावी पीढ़ी को रसायनिक उर्वरकों से दूर रहने का संदेश मिलता है तथा उनमें कार्य के प्रति रुचि बढ़ती है तो पढ़ाई के साथ कमाना भी सीखते हैं तथा उनमें जब आत्मविश्वास बढ़ता है तो स्वावलंबन की भावना विकसित होती है। यह इनके लिए एक तरह का स्टार्टअप है, इस छोटे से स्टार्टअप से ये छात्राएं अपने जीवन यापन के लिए शुद्ध जैविक खेती के माध्यम से अपना जीवन बसर कर अनेक लोगों को रोजगार भी दे सकती हैं। इन छात्राओं के माध्यम से समाज को रसायनिक उर्वरकों एवं कीटनाशकों के दुष्प्रभाव से बचने का संदेश भी मिलेगा।

इस महाविद्यालय का आदर्श वाक्य है " प्रकृति की ओर लौटो" । हम लोगों को प्रकृति से जोड़ना चाहते हैं। इस महाविद्यालय का प्रांगण हरा -भरा है तथा प्लास्टिक मुक्त है। अर्थात् यहां का माहौल इकोफ्रेंडली है।
